Half day city tour of Budva with english speaking guide

The name Old Town, Budva was worn in the Middle Ages, and most of the architecture of this city was of Venetian origin. Doors, windows, balconies and many other parts of the constructions are of Roman style. It kept original form – with its narrow streets, squares and stone staircases leading to the elegant houses with small windows framed by hewn frames and red-tiled roofs. Budva has a large number of cultural and historical monuments, monasteries and churches that document the historical and social events in the area of the Budva Riviera. Among the most famous churches are the church of St. John, built in the seventh century, the church of Santa Maria "in Punta" from 840, the church of the Holy Trinity from 1804. The most famous part of the city walls is called Citadel and is an interesting tourist attraction. The city abounds in beautiful beaches of which the most famous are: Mogren, Slovenska, Bečići, Jaz...

It is a dramatic town where the present lives in the maze of medieval churches, cathedrals, Venetian palaces and pillars. Kotor is made up of contrasts – the old squares with modern cafes, the sounds of serenade and live music, the echo of the footsteps down the narrow cobblestone alleys and the lazy purr of cats lying under the balconies with wrought iron railings, decorated with petunias.

This boat tour to Our Lady of the Rocks and the Blue Cave is one of the most popular tours for visitors to Kotor.

In just three hours you'll see the whole Bay of Kotor, visit Our Lady of the Rocks - the must-see attraction in the bay - and explore Lustica's must-see - the Blue Cave.

And since the tour starts from Kotor Park, just 200m from Kotor old town and Kotor port, it's perfect if you'll only be in Kotor a short time.

Dubrovnik - The City

Few places in the world master the mix of young and modern with the medieval and baroque better than Dubrovnik. The city naturally evolves around the Old Town which is inside the city walls.

The Old Town provides a blend of shops, cafés and bars, a fantastic atmosphere, and some very beautiful sights as you walk along down the Stradun. The squares in the Old Town are lined with bars or restaurants that have outdoor seating, giving the visitors, as well as the locals, a chance to relax with a drink in the sunshine.

Outside the city walls, modern Dubrovnik offers everything you would expect from a Mediterranean country and figs, lemons, oranges and peaches are to be found dangling from the trees in many of the gardens.

The town's architecture displays very little evidence from the 'Siege of Dubrovnik' in 1992, during which more than two thousand bombs were dropped on the town. The only hint of this is the presence of all the newly tiled roofs in town.

Dubrovnik is well worth a visit any time of the year, but, naturally, spring and summer brings out the best in the city.

Beginning at Pile Gate, at the west entrance to the Old City, you will be guided to Dubrovnik's most significant historical landmarks (we won't enter any churches or museums). See: Pile Gate, Cove of Kolorina, Onofrio's Fountains, Orlando's Column, Rector's Palace, Sponza Palace, Stradun (the main street), The Cathedral, Church of St. Blaise, The Wide Street, Square of Ivan Gundulić, some locations where recent popular movies were filmed, like the Game of Thrones and much more.

Take in the beautiful sights, and listen to stories and remarkable facts through the many centuries of Dubrovnik's dramatic history, including the recent past during the Homeland War. The tour ends in the Luža Square (the main city square).
